Thereupon appointed the 13th day of December A.D. 1870
for the hearing of said petition and caused notice to
be served on the Crown Commissioners, also published
Notice of Petition in Keolu & Kona Newspapers.

Nov. 13

Court opened at 10 am.

The petition appeared and called several witnesses
whose evidence is now on file, and from said
evidence, ^{the same} was given ^{in favor of the} defendants ^{not} having called
any witness) and survey ordered as follows.

Survey of Keolu by James Gay.

Commencing at two small stones set into the ground a distance
from a double stemmed tree of India tree of 70 links, bearing
E 4. N. Magnetic. Thence N 67.43 W a distance of 210 links along
the eastern bank of Hanapepe river, thence N 77.28 W a distance
of 461 links crossing a branch of Hanapepe stream, (as shown on plan)
thence N 81.26 W a distance of 942 links crossing the principal
stream of river and running to the eastern side of a water race, the
center of which forms the boundary of the said land,

thence following the said water race to where it joins the Hanapepe
river, having the following bearing & distances.

S 19° 12' W a distance of 420 links, thence S 26° 21' W a distance of 349 links, thence S 39° 20' W a distance of 391 links, thence S 54° 37' W a distance of 1588 links to the river bank, thence following the bank to the sea, with the following bearings and distances S 43° 20' W a distance of 680 links, thence S 64° 33' W a distance of 444 links, thence S 40° 41' W a distance of 879 links, thence S 32° 50' W a distance of 687 links, thence S 34° 31' W a distance of 780 links, thence S 6° 31' W a distance of 1788 links, thence S 15° 51' E a distance of 412 links, thence S 55° 35' E crossing a sandpit & mouth of Manapapa river to a rocky point overlooking the sea, a distance of 1260 links, thence returning on the eastern side of the river to commencement with the following bearings and distances, N 43° 51' E a distance of 643 links, thence N 35° 56' W a distance of 826 links, thence N 16° 7' W a distance of 888 links, thence N 33° 18' a distance of 480 links, thence N 13° 17' E a distance of 542 links, thence N 17° 21' E a distance of 372 links, thence N 32° 37' E a distance of 579 links, thence N 53° 3' E a distance of 689 links, thence N 65° 6' E a distance of 487 links, thence N 56° 15' E a distance of 839 links, thence E 5° 39' S a distance of 583 links, thence E 3° 32' S a distance of 460 links, thence N 40° 41' E a distance of 310 links crossing a slight bend and cutting off a portion of the river as shown on plan, thence N 9° 47' E a distance of 1004 links, thence N 31° 47' E a distance of 267 links, thence N 27° 41' E a distance of ~~220~~ 220 links, thence E 6° 18' S a distance of 236 ^{links} } thence N 71° 29' E (correct) a distance of 519 links. } Error on plan 70.59
