# Boundary of the Ahupuaa of Pohakuau.

The eastern boundary of this land commences at a stone in the sea resembling a shark and called Pohakukimano thence up valley and ridge called Kawaiopoa to an old battle field called Kalehua the latter named place the boundary runs to Kahoi thence to Kahu thence on to peak the junction of this land with Kalabau highest point on Western boundary and called Alaalau thence down Western boundary along Kalabau Puuki thence " " to a resting place on ridge Kawaiopoa thence " " same ridge to peak Puciniu thence " " to flat Keshupohaku thence " " to point on sea beach called Naupaka and round to place of commencement.

From the above and the evidence of several other witnesses the following decision was rendered.

### Decision

The Boundary of this land commences at a stone in the sea at short distance from the shore resembling a shark and called Pohakukimano, thence up valley and ridge Kawaiopoa to an old battle ground Kalehua, thence to Kahoi thence to Kahu thence to peak Alaalau the junction of this land with the Ahupuaa of Kalabau thence down along the Kalabau boundary to a place called Puuki, thence continuing down to a resting place called Kawaiopoa, thence down same ridge to a peak called Puciniu thence down to flat called Keshupohaku, thence to point on sea beach called Naupaka, and thence round to place of commencement
