

Boundary of the Ahupuaa of Honopou

Nakulala Sworn

Commencing at sea shore in the sand at a point between two holes in rocks and called Kalesipika
 Thence to Pale called Kalahui
 " to a peak with hole in it called Keanaupuka
 " to a large flat on top of ridge called Kalahui
 " " stone where Honopou Neulolo
 Wauapuka Waima & Kalalau all join called Pohakewawawa
 " on Western Boundary to peak Puniopou
 " down to a ridge called Keachala
 " said ridge of Keachala to spring at sea. Kawaipapa
 Pale Sworn

The boundary of this land commences on the sea shore at a place called Kalesipika
 Thence to Pale called Kalahui
 " to a peak with hole in it called Keanaupuka
 " to a large flat on top of ridge Kalahui
 " to a large stone where Honopou Wauapuka Neulolo, Waima & Kalalau join
 Pohakewawawa
 Witness does not know the Western boundary.

From the above evidence and that of Woaheki and others the following Decision in reference to the boundary of Honopou was given.

Decision

Find that the Eastern boundary of this land commences on the sea shore between two holes in rocks at a place called Kalesipika Thence to Pale called Kalahui, Thence to high Peak with hole in it called Keanaupuka, Thence to large flat on top of ridge called Kalahui, Thence to a large stone where Honopou, Wauapuka Neulolo, Waima & Kalalau all join & called Pohakewawawa Thence on western boundary to the peak Puniopou, Thence down a ridge called Keachala Thence down said ridge of Keachala to a spring at sea called Kawaipapa, and from thence round to place of commencement
