Ahapuua of Pilaa

Received the following petition

To the Honorable Muncie M. Bryde, Aug^r 28. 1872.
Commissioner of Boundaries &c &c
Island of Kawai

The undersigned Guardians of the person and property of William C. Lenuatila would respectfully ask that the boundaries of the Ahapuua of Pilaa situated in the District of Koolaw Island of Kawai may be defined and settled. Thy survey and notes are herewith filed

The land of Pilaa is bounded by Waipate belonging to Kaila by Papea formerly belonging to the late Rev^d C. Johnson, by Lepiale belonging to the Hawaiian Government and by the sea.

The following witnesses Kuaa, Pihalamua & Kameuluhia were sworn and from their evidence now on file, the following decision was rendered

Ahapuua of Pilaa

Decision in reference to the Boundary of Pilaa (Ahapuua) by Muncie M. Bryde Commissioner of Boundaries 5th Nov 1872

Commencing on the NE boundary at a rocky point on the sea shore near Blow hole

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Ahu Puaa of Pilaa

and thence southward to Kawau, thence to Kaahamahole thence to Kahala tree at Kahala, thence to tree, thence to gulch Kaluanua, thence to stream called Kapua Pilaa, thence to dry gulch Kamahana, thence to junction of three lands Waipaho, Lapaaua, and Pilaa, at a place called Kialowaka thence straight line to Puamoko, thence to Kanopai thence to stream Kalualaea, thence to Chahala tree on ridge Kamamokea, thence along ridge to stream and down stream to Maipapa falls, thence to old house lot Moku thence to Waikuna, thence to rocks Pohakuumalunaleu thence to Palais hill, thence to Alamakai, thence to old Kalo patch Palae, thence to Kualaii thence to a stone in shrub called Pohakuumalunaleu, thence out to edge of reef and round to place of commencement

Situated on Kauai

The N.E. corner of this land commences on the beach at Maipapa a stone on the W side of a small cove on the table rock Maipapa the sea having access to it through an arch and runs thence 128.11 ^{2 1/2} to the top of terrace called Kawau from thence the following steps
