## JUDGMENT.

An application to decide and certify the Boundaries of the Land  
of Waimoa District of Waimoa Island of  
Kauai having been filed with me on the 14 day of July  
1873 by Geo. O. Dennis Commissioner of Lands  
(Crown) and Land Agent  
in accordance with the provisions of an Act to facilitate the settlement of Boundaries, &c., approved on the 22d day of June, A. D. 1868; now, therefore, having duly received and heard all the testimony offered in reference to the said boundaries and, having gone on the said land, at the request of  
James W. Gay  
and having endeavored otherwise to obtain all information possible to enable me to arrive at a just decision, which will more fully appear by reference to the records of this matter by me kept in Book No. 1, page 140, and it appearing to my satisfaction that the true, lawful and equitable boundaries, are as follows, viz:

The south East corner of this land commences at the mouth of the Waimoa River on its Eastern Bank, and thence runs S.W. along the sea shore to Laokohole, thence continuing along beach to Kawauhi, thence to Palacholani thence along shore to Moelawu, thence along shore to Nohole in Wama (Sounding Sands) thence continuing along beach to Kapiiai, thence along beach to Pothali, here ends the sand beach and begins the rocky coast and pales, thence

along the rocky coast to point at Milolū.  
Thence past Alapū point by Neololo to point  
N.E. of Neololo bay and called Pearanai the  
N.W. corner of this land and S.W. corner of Wa-  
rapuhi a Government Land. From this point  
the Boundary runs up face of Pali to Peak and  
continuing along the ridge to Pohakuaia  
a large and peculiarly shaped stone, on the  
East brow of Kaumūhua ridge. From this stone  
the Boundary follows the watershed of the Kau-  
mūhua ridge through forest land, and along  
the top of Pali overlooking Katalau to the  
top of a high noted peak called Pūpūhea  
the S.E. corner of Katalau and S.W. corner of Poha-  
kuaia. Thence the Boundary continues along  
watershed of mountain range bounded on the  
East by the Land of Wainiha to where it joins  
the land of Makawele at a place called Ka-  
potai the N.E. corner of this land and S.W. corner  
of Wainiha.

The Eastern Boundary of this land  
runs from place of commencement along the land  
of Makawele up the Eastern Banks of the Wainiha  
River to opposite the junction of the Wainiha and  
Makawele rivers. Thence up along East bank  
of river to Stens - - - Thence to causway and  
up to cliff above Makawele Valley. Thence  
up ridge to cactus bushes. Thence up ridge  
to top of Nahakau. Thence to Kalehuakihaki  
the North West corner of Makawele. Thence

following in an Easterly Direction the Watershed  
of the Ridge, to Kapohi the East corner of this  
land and junction with the N.E. boundary.

It is therefore adjudged and I  
do hereby decide and certify that the boundaries  
of the said land are and hereafter shall be as  
heretofore set forth.

The South East corner of these lands commence at

The Survey commences at a trig Station on the South  
west corner of old Russian Fort on the bank of Kāhūi

bear  $S 88^{\circ} 37' E$  true var. of the Yards  $7' 10''$ . Kāhūi  
Kāhūi peak a high range on the boundary on these  
lands and Kāhūi bear  $N 26^{\circ} 50' E$  true  $4' 19'' 20''$  mag.  
Thence the S and W boundary of these lands runs along  
the sea coast as far as Kāhūi point when  
it joins the Government land of Kāhūi notes
